Prepare catch

Included in the package:

- 3 days fishing - 8 hours fishing daily
- Bait
- 2 experienced crew members
- Tea/coffee/mineral water/cake/sandwiches/warm meal
- One evening host will prepare catch and you will have a fishdinner at his private home
- Possibility to take home your catch frozen, max 20 kg per person

Minimum 4 persons and maximum 10 persons.

We offer hours of uninterrupted deep sea fishing in the crystal clear North Atlantic waters. We also offer the option to rent good quality rods and reels as well as the purchase of tackle. Water depths will be approx. 20m to 150m. The catch would most likely be cod, haddock, ling and colefish etc. Last but not least you may be lucky enough to catch halibut !!!!!
